1. This Act may be cited as the East African Community Short title Customs Management (Amendment) Act, 2007 and shall be deemed to have come into force on the 1st day of January, 2007.

2. The East African Community Customs Management Act, 2004 hereinafter referred to as the "principal Act" is amended in section 48 (4) by inserting the words "of their release" between the words "days" and "be" appearing in the second line.

3. The principal Act is amended in section 57(1) by Amendment substituting for the word "three" appearing in the second line the 57 (1). word "six".

4. The principal Act is amended in section 112(2) by Amendment substituting the phrase "31st December, 2006" with the phrase of secure 112 (2). "31st December, 2008".
