SUBJECT: RESUMPTION OF EALA PLENARY BUSINESS, ARUSHA - TANZANIA

The East African Legislative Assembly (EALA) Plenary Business is scheduled to commence on **19th June 2026**. Members are expected to arrive in Arusha on **18th June 2026**, except for Members of the *Accounts Committee*, who are required to travel on **16th June 2026**.

The purpose of this memo is to inform and request you to make the necessary preparations. Kindly note the following:-

- (i) The 1st Phase of the Plenary Session will conclude on **22nd June 2026**, while Phase II is expected to commence on **29th June 2026**;
- (ii) The provisional programme and related schedules will be circulated to you as soon as finalized by the Commission Sub-Committee on Legislative Business;
- (iii) Arusha is currently experiencing cold weather conditions. You are therefore advised to carry adequate warm clothing for the duration of your stay;
- (iv) The prescribed dress code at the EAC Headquarters is **Official Business Attire (Suits)** at all times. Male Members are required to wear suits with neckties;
