RESOLUTION OF THE ASSEMBLY CONGRATULATING PRESIDENT BARACK OBAMA UPON HIS RE-ELECTION AS THE 44TH PRESIDENT OF THE UNITED STATES OF AMERICA

Moved by Hon. Hafsa Mossi and adopted by the Assembly on Wednesday January 30th, 2013
