A RESOLUTION OF THE ASSEMBLY TO HOLD A SITTING IN THE REPUBLIC OF UGANDA

WHEREAS Clause (1) of Article 136 of the Treaty states that the headquarters of the Community shall be in Arusha, in the United Republic of Tanzania;

AND WHEREAS Clause (1) of the Article 55 of the Treaty states that the Meetings of the Assembly shall be held at such times and places as the Assembly may appoint;

AND WHEREAS Rule 2 of the Rules of Procedure states that the Seat of the Assembly shall be at Arusha, the United Republic of Tanzania;

AND WHEREAS Sub Rule (7) of Rule 11 of the Rules of Procedure states that the Assembly may, on a resolution adopted by a majority

of its Members, decide to hold one or more sittings elsewhere with the Partner States, other than its Seat;

NOW THEREFORE THIS ASSEMBLY DO RESOLVE as follows:-

That pursuant to the Provisions of Sub Rule (7) of Rule 11 cited above, the Assembly shall hold sittings in the Parliament of Uganda from today Wednesday, June 20, 2007 to Friday, June 22, 2007.
