**An Act to apply a sum of United States Dollars eleven million eight hundred ninety two thousand eight hundred and ninety nine out of the Budget of the East African Community to meet the expenditure of the Community for the year ending on the 30<sup>th</sup> June, 2005 and to appropriate the supplies granted.**

ENACTED by the East African Community and assented to by the President of the United Republic of Tanzania, the President of the Republic of Kenya and the President of the Republic of Uganda.

*Appropriation*

---

1. This Act may be cited as the East African Community Appropriation Act 2004 and shall be deemed to have come into force on the 1<sup>st</sup> day of July 2004.

2. The Secretary General may issue out of the Budget of the East African Community and apply towards the supply granted to the Community for the services of the year ending on the 30<sup>th</sup> June, 2005, the sum of United States Dollars eleven million eight hundred ninety two thousand eight hundred and ninety nine.

3. The sums granted by this Act shall be appropriated for the services and purposes specified in the Schedule to this Act.

4. Any part of the sums granted by section 2 of this Act which has been, or is issued from the Budget of the East African Community on or before the 30<sup>th</sup> day of June, 2005 shall be available until a date to be determined by the Council of Ministers, not being later than the 31<sup>st</sup> day of December, 2005 for making payments which become due during the year ending on the 30<sup>th</sup> day of June, 2005.
